Grahamsville artist exhibits work at CWC

“Mountain Musings,” an exhibition of 23 paintings by Ann Higgins of Grahamsville, is on view at the Catskill Watershed Corporation (CWC), 905 Main Street, Margaretville through September.

The exhibit, primarily watercolors, can be seen from 8 to 4:30 Monday through Friday except holidays.

A farmstead in a foggy valley, sunlight piercing the gloom of the forest, colorful rocks and pebbles seen through the crystal water of a mountain stream, all caught artist Higgins’ discerning eye. Her paintings capture the commonplace in field and forest, and in the backyard, where birds at the feeder, a blossom in the garden, even clothes on the line, become her subjects.

A graduate of Rhode Island School of Design, Ann Higgins earned a Master’s degree from SUNY New Paltz. She taught art at Liberty Central School for many years before devoting herself to art full time.

She has given private lessons and workshops for a number of art societies. Ann is a signature member of the Northeast Watercolor Association, the Association of Aviation Artists and a number of miniature art societies. Her paintings have been exhibited locally, nationally and internationally.
