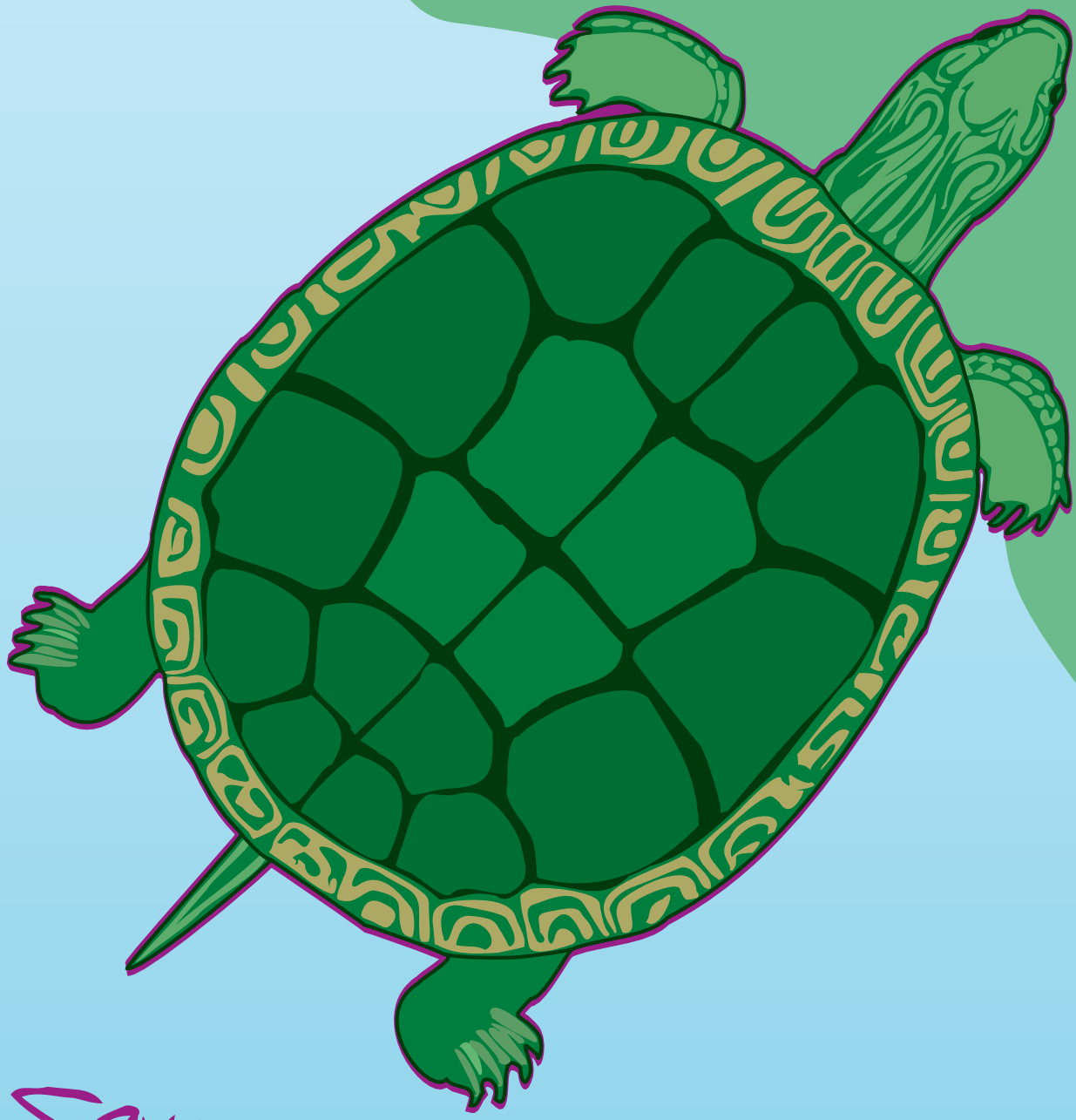


Help Your Watershed

Save water. Every drop you save means more water for fish, wildlife, and plants.

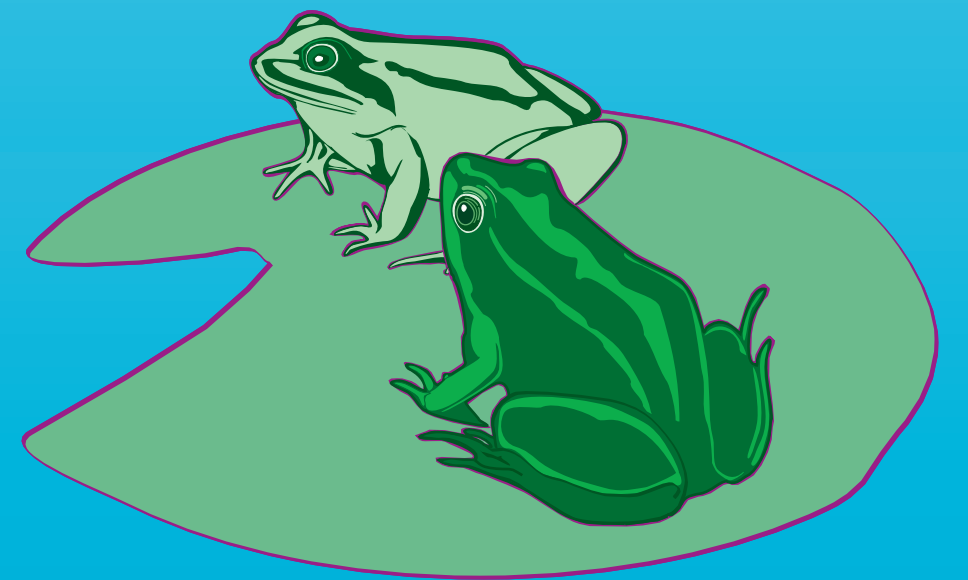
Take a hike, ride a bike. Get around using kid power if you can.
