



## **Public Information and Education MINUTES April 5, 2016**

The meeting was called to order at 11:10 a.m.

1. Minutes from the January 2016 meeting were accepted without change.
2. PEAG's Round 19 grant recommendations were distributed and reviewed. 22 of 25 proposals for student-teacher audiences were recommended for full or partial funding totaling \$149,906; 4 of 5 proposals for adult general/audiences totaling \$15,000 were recommended. Marty moved, Innes seconded to send this roster of recommended grants to the full CWC Board in May. All in favor.
3. Diane provided an update on Round 17 final reports – all have been submitted, with two projects still under extension. Round 18 projects are proceeding. Two of note attracted large audiences in the past month – a performance by Arm of the Sea Theater at Phoenicia Elementary School April 3, sponsored by Phoenicia Library, drew an SRO crowd of 150; while on March 11, 150 students and 25 teachers participated in a Climate Change Youth Summit in Delhi organized by CCE Delaware County.
