CWC Approves Funding for Flood Hazard, Future Stormwater and Many Septic Projects

ARKVILLE, N.Y., January 8, 2021– On January 5, the Catskill Watershed Corporation (CWC) Board of Directors approved funding for projects in the Flood Hazard, Future Stormwater and Septic Rehabilitation and Replacement Programs.

Funding from the Flood Hazard Mitigation Program was approved for demolishing a structure on a NYCDEP funded flood buyout property at 1798 State Route 214 in the Town of Hunter.

Funding from the Future Stormwater and MOA 145 Program was approved for construction costs of NYCDEP required stormwater control measures for Hunter Peaks LLC in the Town of Hunter.

The CWC Board of Directors awarded funding for replacement septic systems and additional construction costs to a total of 10 homeowners in six towns in Delaware, Greene and Ulster Counties.
