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CWC Approves Funding for Many Septic Projects and Flood Hazard

ARKVILLE, N.Y., February 5, 2021– On February 2, the Catskill Watershed Corporation (CWC) Board of Directors approved funding for many projects in the Septic program as well as the Flood Hazard program.

The CWC Board of Directors awarded funding for replacement septic systems and additional construction costs to a total of 12 homeowners in six towns in Delaware and Greene Counties.

Funding from the Flood Hazard Mitigation Program was approved for a feasibility study in the Village of Hunter. The program was also approved to enter an agreement with Tweedie Construction Services for removal of underground fuel oil tank(s) at a proposed NYCDEP funded flood buyout property.

The CWC is a non-profit, Local Development Corporation responsible for several environmental protection, economic development, and education programs in the New York City Watershed West of the Hudson River. www.cwconline.org
