CWC Approves Funding for Stormwater Design and Septic System Repairs

ARKVILLE, N.Y., March 4, 2022– On March 1, the Catskill Watershed Corporation (CWC) Board of Directors approved funding for several projects in the Septic and Stormwater Programs.

Funding was approved for DEP required stormwater design costs associated with a residence in the Town of Kortright. This project will include the installation of two rain gardens to treat runoff from the three-bedroom residence and a third rain garden to treat runoff from a one-bedroom residence.

The Board also approved DEP required stormwater design costs for stormwater controls for a subdivision of four lots in the Town of Hunter. Stormwater measures will include rain gardens for each individual house as well as two bioretention areas, two stormwater management ponds and a rain garden to treat runoff from the access road.

Six homeowners in six towns in Delaware, Greene and Ulster Counties were awarded reimbursement grants for septic repairs or replacements.
