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CWC Approves Funding for Septic System Repairs

ARKVILLE, N.Y., June 15, 2022– On June 7, the Catskill Watershed Corporation (CWC) Board of Directors approved funding for several projects in the Septic Program and three projects under the Flood Hazard Mitigation Implementation Program.

Eighteen homeowners in 13 towns in Delaware, Greene, Schoharie, Sullivan and Ulster Counties were awarded reimbursement grants for septic repairs or replacements to provide functioning septic systems.

The Board approved two demolition projects under the Flood Hazard Mitigation Implementation Program. Both demolitions are for properties that were purchased with NYCDEP funding under their Flood Buyout Program and were required to be locally approved by the Village of Tannersville where both are located. The first awarded bid to Tweedie Construction for a demolition. The second resolution approved additional funds to Tweedie Construction for additional expenses beyond their original bid.

The CWC Board also approved funding for flood mitigation design costs for a building in the Town of Hunter to flood proof and elevate the structure.

The CWC is a locally based and locally staffed non-profit Local Development Corporation responsible for several environmental protection, economic development, and education programs in the New York City Watershed West of the Hudson River. www.cwconline.org
