## **CWC Approves Funding for Septic System Repairs and a Future Stormwater Project**

ARKVILLE, N.Y., November 5, 2021– On November 2, the Catskill Watershed Corporation (CWC) Board of Directors approved funding for several projects in the Septic and Future Stormwater Programs.

Fourteen homeowners in 11 towns in Delaware, Greene, and Ulster Counties were awarded reimbursement grants for replacement septic systems. CWC has funded over 190 septic repairs and replacements throughout the Watershed this year.

A property owner in the Town of Woodstock, Ulster County was approved funding for design and construction of Stormwater controls required by NYC DEP. Among the items approved for reimbursement are, vegetative filter strips, culverts, plantings, a pond forebay and a larger main pond with a retaining wall.

The CWC is a locally based and locally staffed non-profit, Local Development Corporation responsible for several environmental protection, economic development, and education programs in the New York City Watershed West of the Hudson River.
