CWC Approves Funding for Many Septic Repairs and Replacements

ARKVILLE, N.Y., January 5, 2023– On January 3, the Catskill Watershed Corporation (CWC) Board of Directors approved funding for several projects under the Septic Repair and Replacement Program.

The CWC Board approved funding to Twenty-Four homeowners in 13 towns in Delaware, Greene, and Ulster Counties who were awarded reimbursement grants for septic repairs or replacements to provide functioning septic systems throughout the Watershed. Some of these replacements consisted of additional reimbursement due to additional work corroborated by the homeowner's engineer, material price increases, or second time repair for systems that were replaced more than twenty years ago under a previous CWC grant to the property owner. Construction will be completed by contractors of the homeowner's choosing. Homeowners experiencing septic issues are encouraged to contact CWC directly.
