They are not included in the staff estimated cost of construction based on the Schedule of Values. Bruce Moore Second Time Repair: The property is in the Town of Neversink, SBL: 30-1-65. This project was paid for in 1999 under our Reimbursement Program under a previous owner. The absorption field appears to have failed. It is leaching into footer drains and running over the bank towards the stream. Staff recommend replacing the entire system. The homeowner had maintenance pump outs done in 2015, 2022 and in 2025. Discussion.

Cynthia Quiroga Second Time Repair: The property is in the Town of Middletown, SBL: 327-1-37. This project was paid for in 2014 under our Priority 8 Program under a previous owner. The absorption field is no longer accepting effluent and is backing up into the house. Staff recommend replacing the entire system. The homeowner had maintenance pump outs done in 2024 and 2026.
