Catskill Watershed Corporation to Highlight More Than \$20 Million in Community Investments at 2026 Annual Meeting

ARKVILLE, N.Y. — The Catskill Watershed Corporation (CWC) will welcome local, regional, and state leaders to its 2025 Annual Meeting of member towns this July as the organization reflects on another successful year of investing in the vitality and resilience of Catskill and Delaware Watershed communities.

Over the past year, CWC has invested more than **\$20 million** across programs that strengthen the region's economy, infrastructure, workforce, and quality of life. These investments have supported residential, civic, and **commercial infrastructure projects; economic development initiatives; education and outreach efforts; and workforce development opportunities** throughout the Watershed region.

Serving communities across **five counties; Delaware, Greene, Schoharie, Sullivan, and Ulster; including forty-one towns and eight villages**, CWC continues its mission of protecting water quality while helping local communities thrive.

This year's Annual Meeting has been **moved to July** to better accommodate the schedules of state leadership and encourage broader participation from elected officials and community stakeholders.

"The Annual Meeting provides a unique opportunity to bring together the people and organizations working every day to strengthen this extraordinary region," said Jason Merwin, CWC Executive Director. "State leaders will have the chance to connect directly with town supervisors, mayors, and local decision-makers from across their districts, while regional officials can engage with representatives from CWC, the New York City Department of Environmental Protection, and other key environmental partners committed to protecting and building up the Catskill and Delaware Watersheds."

Attendees will hear highlights from the past year, learn more about the impact of CWC's programs, and gain insight into emerging opportunities and priorities for the future.

As home purchases, tourism, and investment continue to grow throughout the region, the work of balancing environmental stewardship with community prosperity has never been more important.

CWC invites municipal leaders, community partners, elected officials, and interested members of the public to join the conversation and celebrate the collective work being done to ensure the long-term success of the Watershed communities we call home.
